CHOICE BASED CREDIT SYSTEM (CBCS)

Choice Based Credit System (CBCS)

The CBCS provides an opportunity for the students to choose courses from the prescribed courses comprising core, elective/generic/skill based courses. The courses can be evaluated following the grading system, which is considered to be better than the conventional marks system. In order to bring uniformity in evaluation system and computation of the Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) based on student's performance in examinations, the UGC has formulated a uniform template for that.

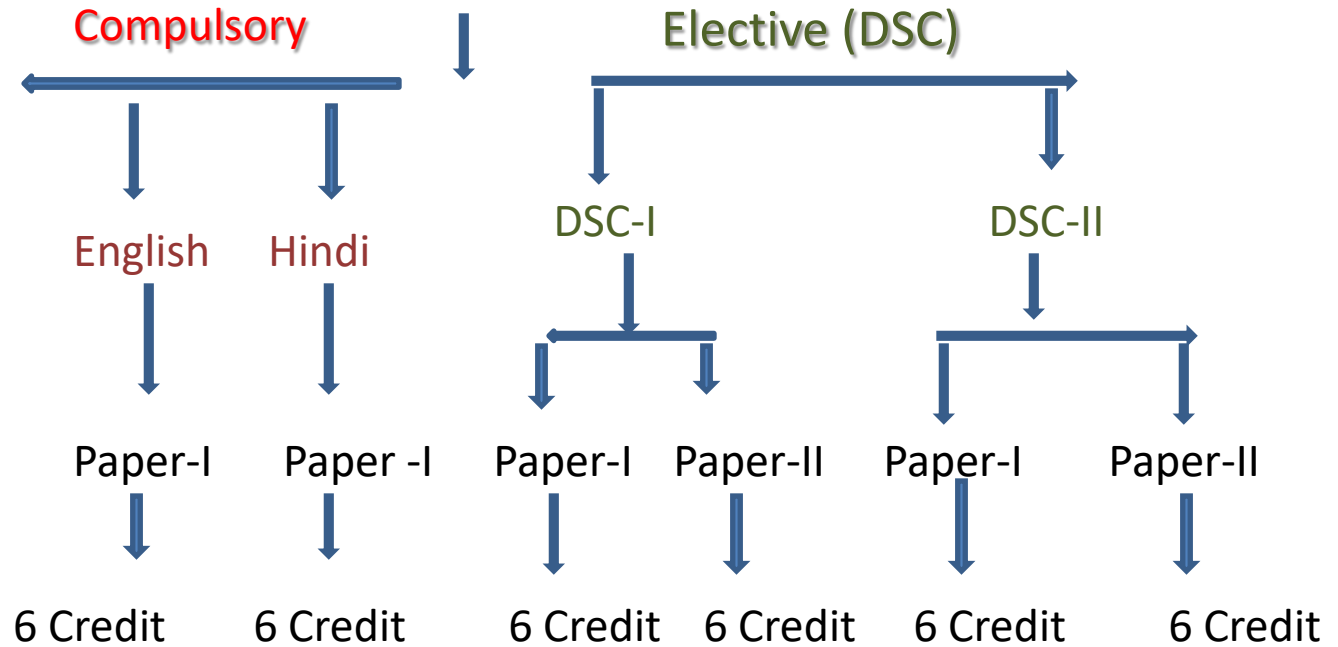
Structure of CBCS

- Himachal Pradesh University has adopted the annual system of CBCS from 2018.
- It has adopted the UGC template with the following courses for BA.
- **Core Course (CC)**- A course, which should compulsorily be studied by a candidate as a core requirement.
- **Elective Course**: Generally a course which can be chosen from a pool of courses, Discipline Specific Core (DSC-I, DSC –II)
- **Ability Enhancement Compulsory Courses (AECC)**:
- **Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC)**:
- **Discipline Specific Elective (DSE) Course**:
- **Generic Elective (GE) Course**:

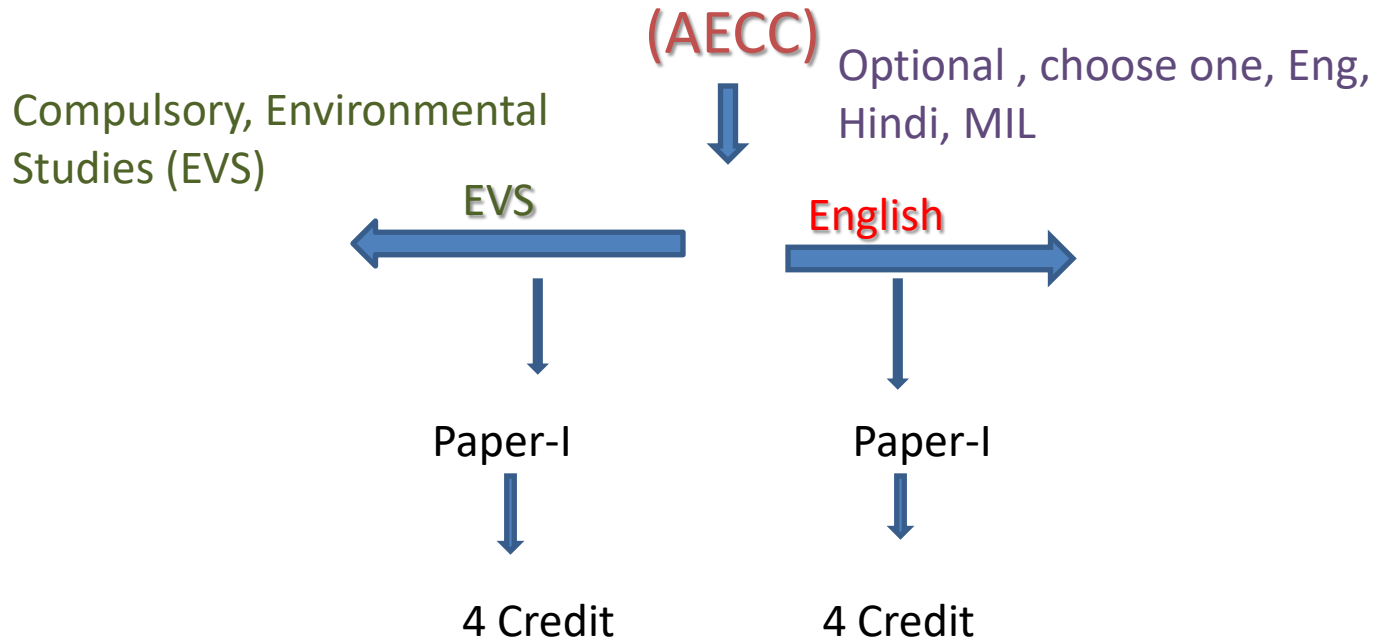

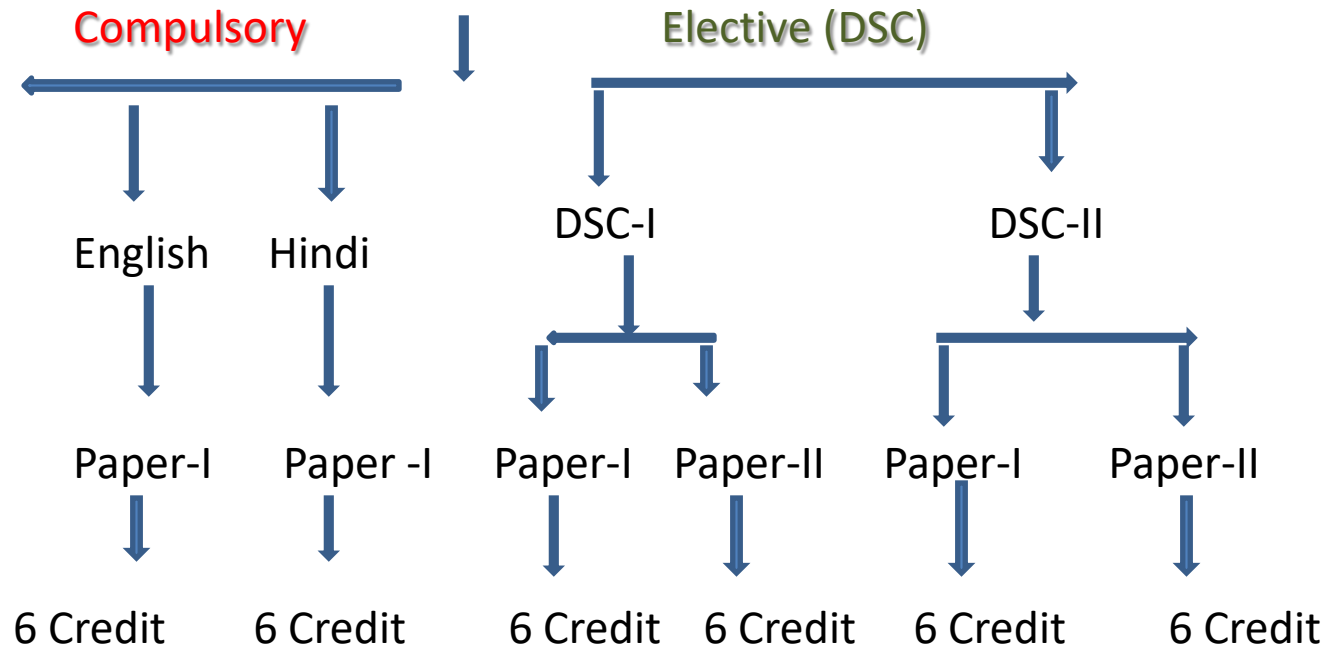

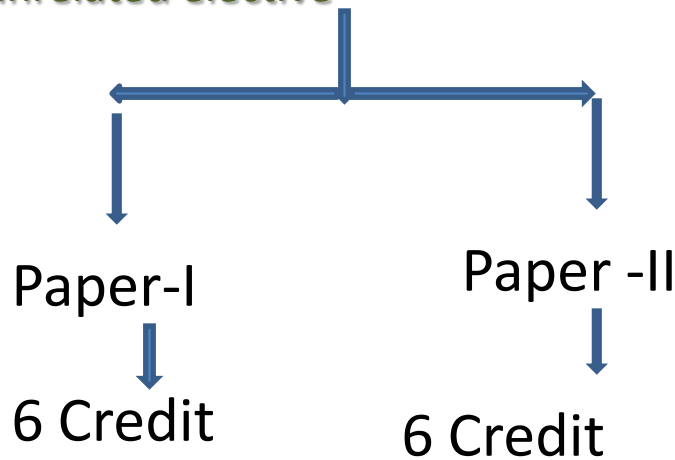

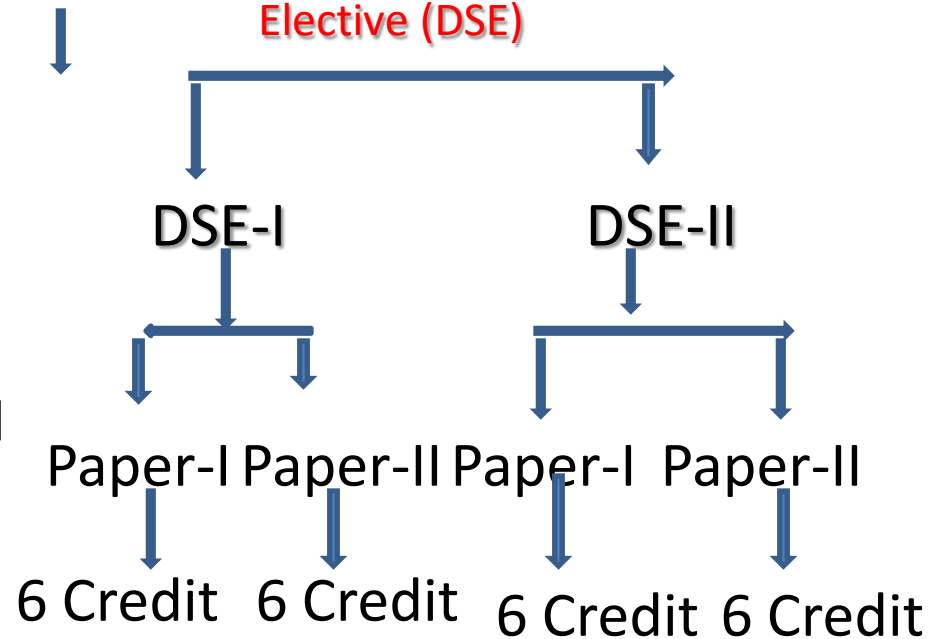


Generic Elective and DSE

Generic Elective to be opted beyond DSC-I and DSC-II or unrelated elective



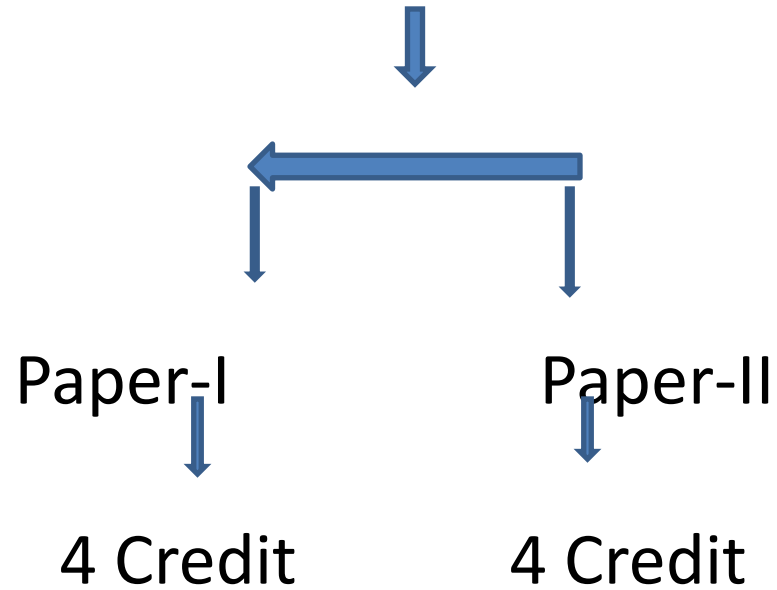
