Centre of Excellence, Govt. College Sanjauli an institution of eminence in Himachal Pradesh came into being in 1969 on the scenario of education offering Arts, Science, Commerce and BCA at under graduate level enrolling 2665 students (Boys – 1549, Girls – 1116) in different streams. The college takes pride in its rich history and different titles assigned to it from time to time. The structure of the main building, currently housing Administrative Block and Computer laboratories reminds one of the primordial days. The architect A. Gaddock designed the structure of the building. The college was constructed in April 1869 by Harriet Christina Tyler. In the beginning it was an institution used as an industrial orphanage under the name of Himalayan Christina Orphanage and named as North Stoneham. Later in 1872, the same institution was reconstituted as the Mayo Industrial School for female orphans and other girls of European extraction. However, later it was rebuilt at a grand cost of Rs. 73545/- and was opened for use on March 1, 1905 during the Lieutenant-Governorship of Sir Charles Rivoz, K.C.SJ., and the Episcopate of the Reverend George Alfred Lefroy, D.D., the third Bishop of Lahore. After independence, this institution was converted into a B.Ed/B.T. college for girls affiliated to Punjab University, till it attained its present position.

Sir, with your kind permission I would like to present a brief introduction and achievements of the college during the session 2015-2016.

Jijeevisha – A Social Outreach Cell

Comprising of 25 members was born of a desire to engage in meaningful interaction with those who have not been as lucky as others. The student members took turns to lend a helping hand to the patients and staff at the cancer wing of IGMC. Two students went there every day to help in the canteen, at the blood collection centre and in OPD. The members of the cell collected funds to buy quilts, heaters, shoes and flooring for the Shishu Griha, a home for deserted babies. They visited the Shishu Griha once in fifteen days to spend time with the inmates. To raise awareness regarding the existence and activities of the cell, a flash mob was organized in the college compound on the 21st of August. It has been a very satisfying experience for each member of the cell.

Red Cross Society

The society is very active in the college. Under the supervision of Prof. G.P. Kapoor (convener) ten students along with Counsellor Mr. Bisham Lal participated in an All India Camp (16-23 April) at Panchkula. The team was acknowledged as the best performer.

IGNOU Study Centre-1101

Indira Gandhi National Open University, New Delhi has opened a study centre to cater to the needs of the learners who are residing in the remote areas of Himachal Pradesh. The object of this centre is to provide the best opportunities of education to every keen learner in different job oriented courses, such as Tourism Studies, Computer Programme, Rural Development, Food & Nutrition, Human Rights and Bachelor's Degree in Arts and Commerce. During the session, 2200 learners were enrolled in this centre under the supervision of Dr. Gopal Krishan Chauhan (Coordinator), Dr. Vinay Mohan Sharma and Sh. Muneet Lakhanpal. (Assistant coordinators). This centre is one of the best centre of the Zone.

IQAC (Internal Quality Assurance Cell)





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The main aim of IQAC is to sensitize the college students about the vision and mission of the college and improvement in teaching and learning methods to impart quality education. Teachers' Evaluation Programme was organized to improve the quality of education and a workshop on 'Stress Management' was organized for teachers and students and the prospective plan of IQAC was also submitted this year.

Committee for Prevention of Sexual Harassment and Women Development Cell

To ensure Gender Equality and Gender Justice the college has an active Women Development Cell convened by Dr. Kaushal Kaur. The cell provides platform for listening to the various complaints related to sexual harassment of girls and female employees. The objective of these committees is to redress women grievances, to sensitize them and also to make them aware of their rights. The following activities were performed during the session:

- 1) Gender Champion Cell comprising of ten students was constituted this year. The purpose of this cell is to interact with the society through gender champions, to bring to the notice any gender related issues and also to spread awareness in the community.
- 2) Students attended a talk on honour killing organized by YWCA at Ritz Shimla in which students presented their views.
- 3) The committee organized a legal sensitization programme on "Women Issues, Sensitization and Gender Champion" in which Ms. Kritika Singh, Director Co-coordinator at Efficacious Judicial Academy Shimla was invited as a resource person.
- 4) International Woman's Day was celebrated on 8th March 2016 in which prominent women personalities like Professor Meenakshi Faith Paul and Civil Judge Cum Judicial Magistrate, Miss Sonal Thama were invited to interact with the students. A fashion show with the theme "Empowering Women, Empowering Humanity" was also exhibited which received widespread acclamation.
- 5) Members of Women Cell participated in the Workshop on "Gender Equality: Issues and Challenges organized by HPU on 30th Nov 2015.
- 6) As an outreach programme the cell organized a visit to the Cancer Unit at IGMC Shimla where the volunteers distributed fruits and juices amongst the patients.
