



A report on Anti-Drug Campaign

The Centre of Excellence, Government College Sanjauli, (Shimla) launched an anti-drug campaign on 15th November 2019 to eradicate drug abuse among youth. In the college premises, Principal Dr. Chandra Bhan Mehta launched a huge rally by administering an oath “Intoxication: neither will not let” commemorating our duties as responsible citizens of the society. In which more than 600 students and college staff including NSS volunteers, NCC cadets, Rovers & rangers marched from the college to Sanjauli Chowk and raised slogans for the purpose of prevention of intoxication and total destruction of intoxication from the society. In this rally, slogans sent a message to people to be aware of the evil of drugs: “*Nasha nash ki jadd hai bhai, isne desh mai aag lagaayi...*”

On the other side, our 20 NSS volunteers participated in another event with NSS programme officer Prof. Vikram Bhardwaj at Ridge Ground, Shimla, Where Hon’ble C.M. Shri Jairam Thakur administered the same oath against Drug Abuse.

The Principal Dr. Mehta said that different committees of all the teachers have been formed for the successful organization of this program, through which the NSS volunteers, NCC cadets and Rover & Rangers will motivate the youth in different groups to stay away from drugs. Apart from campaigning, Various programs, slogan writing, Quiz competitions, street plays, direct interaction with students and their parents will be organized. Movies and documentaries will be showing to motivate the students to stay away from addiction and to participate in various sports activities. NSS Programme officer Dr. Minakshi Sharma said that our NSS Volunteers will give full support to the college administration to make this campaign successful and eradicate addiction from Himachal.
