

Report on Ambulance Man Proficiency Badge Training





Date: September 2025 to 5 December 2025

Location: Primary Health Centre (PHC), Sanjauli, Shimla



The BSGHP Sanjauli Unit successfully conducted and completed the *Ambulance Man Proficiency Badge Training* over a structured period of *three months*, commencing in *September 2025* and concluding on *5 December 2025*. The training was held at the *Primary Health Centre (PHC), Sanjauli*, after duly obtaining prior permission from the *Chief Medical Officer (CMO), Shimla*, ensuring full institutional compliance and professional supervision.






The primary objective of this training programme was to inculcate comprehensive *first-aid knowledge*, sharpen *emergency response capabilities*, and nurture *discipline, teamwork, and an enduring spirit of service* among the participants. The training adopted a balanced approach, integrating *theoretical instruction* with *intensive hands-on practical exposure*, delivered under proper guidance in a real medical environment.

Throughout the training duration, participants were systematically trained in a wide range of *life-saving skills*. These included *basic first aid, Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR), patient handling techniques*, and *various rescue procedures*.



Detailed instruction was provided on the management of *cuts, wounds, burns, bleeding, fractures, fainting*, and other common medical emergencies. Special emphasis was placed on the *safe lifting and transportation of patients, the correct use of first-aid equipment*, and the importance of *maintaining composure, alertness, and presence of mind* during critical situations.
