Plantation of Herbal Plants in College Campus

Plantation Proposal

Plant Procurement

After receiving approval for the plantation initiative, the Eco Club and Botany Department took prompt action to procure suitable plants. On August 8, 2023, the Eco Club coordinated with the Himalayan Research and Forestry Institute (HRFI) located in Panthaghati, Shimla, to source the plants. The HRFI, known for its expertise in

forestry and plant conservation, was chosen as the supplier due to their commitment to providing high-quality indigenous plants.

Plant Collection

The plants were successfully collected from HRFI on August 18, 2023. Dr. Sandeep Sharma, a distinguished scientist and director of HRFI, graciously handed over the plants to the Eco Club members at the HRFI premises in Panthaghati, Shimla. The plants were carefully selected to ensure they were well-suited for the local climate and soil conditions

Plantation Event

In keeping with the timeline, the members of the Eco Club proceeded to plant the acquired saplings within the college campus on August 21, 2023. The college campus itself served as the site for the plantation initiative. This strategic decision allowed students, faculty, and staff to witness and engage in the process, thereby raising awareness about the significance of environmental conservation.
