








## What is e Waste ?

- E-waste is electronic products that are unwanted, not working, and nearing or at the end of their "useful life." Computers, televisions, VCRs, stereos, copiers, and fax machines are everyday electronic products.
- The definition of e-waste that has been agreed by StEP is
- "E-Waste is a term used to cover items of all types of electrical and electronic equipment (EEE) and its parts that have been discarded by the owner as waste without the intention of re-use."






Fig 2 State wise E-waste Generation in India (Tonnes/year)
