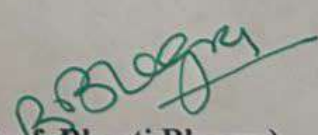

Day - 1

Today, on Thursday, July 9, 2026, the Principal's Address and Induction Program was organized for the first-semester students of B.Sc., B.Com., BBA, BCA, and B.Voc. at the Centre of Excellence Government College, Sanjauli.
