National Education Policy (NEP 2020)

One day workshop on NEP- National Education Policy was organized on 19-09-2020 in Government College Sanjauli under the dynamic leadership and guidance of Principal Dr. C.B.Mehta.



Prof. Sunil Gupta, Chairman Higher Education Council, H.P. was the keynote speaker of the seminar. Prof. Gupta acquainted the august gathering with the guidelines of NEP 2020. He said that the new National Education Policy aims to re-orient the education system towards meeting the needs of the twenty first century by achieving the twin objectives of inclusion and excellence.

Higher education institutions have greater responsibility of making India a global knowledge superpower. The quality standards set as benchmark by these institutions would be followed by other institutions. He said the fundamental principles of the new policy include inculcating creativity and critical thinking in

order to encourage logical decision making and innovation. He further highlighted NEP also seeks to encourage critical thinking and spirit of enquiry. He said that NEP 2020 will help in bringing multidimensional changes right from the regulatory framework to curriculum structure and research environment. He said that NEP 2020 has flexible UG courses with multiple entries and exits. He also stressed that NEP 2020 focuses on the use of technology in higher education and has greater autonomy and multidisciplinary approach.
