Over the past three years, the NSS unit of Government College Sanjauli has actively organized and conducted a series of awareness programs focused on AIDS, in collaboration with the Red Ribbon Club. The first program was an online awareness event held on **December 1, 2020**, which saw the participation of 50 dedicated volunteers. Building on this momentum, the subsequent years witnessed a return to offline formats, with the second program taking place on **December 1, 2021**. The third and most recent program, held on **December 1, 2022**, saw an even higher turnout, with 110 volunteers actively participating. These consecutive programs underscore the NSS unit's commitment to raising awareness about AIDS and highlight the collaborative efforts with the Red Ribbon Club to



educate and empower the community on this critical health issue.






• World Environment Day:






