Introduction:

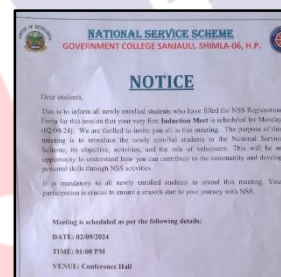
