Please find below the **Organization & Service Profile:**

We, Medswan Foundation have been selected by the Govt. of Himachal Pradesh & National Health Mission, H.P. as the implementing agency for Operation & Maintenance of NAS-108 & JSSK-102 Ambulance Services in the State of Himachal Pradesh.

The 108 ambulance service is a 24 x 7 emergency service which is operated across different parts of the State and is manned by a Pilot who drives the ambulance and an EMT (Emergency Medical Technician, a person from medical background) who takes care of the patient and gives him/ her appropriate pre-hospital care while the patient is taken to the nearest medical facility.

The location of the incident scene (from where the Emergency has been reported at the call centre) is given to the EMT of the nearest ambulance over phone and upon receiving such directions from the response centre; the Pilot drives the ambulance towards the incident scene. Upon reaching the incident location, the Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) checks the vitals of the patient, shifts the patient inside the ambulance and continues to provide appropriate pre-hospital care inside the ambulance throughout the journey. The patient is then admitted at the nearest health facility under the supervision of Medical officer of that health facility. The complete documentation of the case handled is recorded by the EMT on the register provided inside the ambulance.
